Georgia's Dual Enrollment

- Up to 30 hours of college credit free of charge to eligible high school students
- Designed to prepare high school students for college and career opportunities



Dual Enrollment Courses

- Students take college courses and receive both high school and college credit when upon successful completion.
- Academic and career technical course options



Benefits of Dual Enrollment

- Earn high school and college credit simultaneously
- 30 hours of college credit is approximately one year of college
- DE can save money
- DE students have additional safety nets and support from their high school and from their family at home
- DE technical certificates prepare students to enter the workforce

Dual Enrollment Options

Eligibility: 11th and 12th graders with a 2.0 GPA

Courses: Academic and Career Technical

Location: courses are offered at your high school, CCA, and GNTC campus

Application Deadline: May 1st and October 1st



Dual Enrollment Options

Eligibility: 11th and 12th graders with a 3.7 academic GPA or 3.2-3.7 GPA and meet test requirements

Courses: Academic

Location: courses are offered at the CCA and DSC campus

Application Deadline: July 1st and December 1st



Application Process

- Work with counselor
- Apply directly with the college
- Complete the GAFutures Funding App
- Work with counselor to select courses



Dual Enrollment Credits

- DE credits transfer to other colleges and universities in Georgia and many in other states.
- Depending on a student's course of study after graduation, some dual enrollment courses are more beneficial than others
- School counselors will guide students through the dual enrollment process to ensure that their dual enrollment courses will transfer to their intended college.

DE vs AP

Dual Enrollment

- College courses
- Rigorous and fast pace
- Courses are posted to the student's high school transcript and college transcript
- Public Georgia colleges and universities and most private Georgia colleges accept DE credits

Advanced Placement

- High school courses
- Rigorous and fast pace
- College credit is not guaranteed
- Highly competitive out of state universities may expect AP courses on a high school transcript. Students considering such schools should check with the university's admissions office for further guidance
